

Edwardsville Public Library: Download E-Books



Kindles

- Go to www.edwardsvillelibrary.org (you'll need an Edwardsville Library Card barcode and your library pin number – call 692-7556 if you need a pin)
- Click on the OverDrive icon in the center/left of our home page.
- Click on the “Advanced Search” option at the top/right of page (under search bar)
- Click the dropdown menu for “Formats” and choose Kindle Book, then click “Search”
 - *You have the option to check the box to “only show titles with copies available”*
- Browse from our selection of over 1,600 Kindle E-Books. Search by Title / Author in Search bar, or sort by categories under search bar.
 - “Place a Hold” means all available copies are checked out and you can be on the list of next available.
 - “Add to Cart” means the title is available are you’re ready to go.
 - For either option, make sure you click the links for the **Kindle Book format**.
- Once you have made your selections, click the “Proceed to Checkout” link.
- Select “Edwardsville Public Library” from the drop down menu.
- Type in your Library barcode from the back of your card (no spaces) and your four-digit pin.
- Click the drop-down menu to choose a “Lending Period.”
- Click “Confirm Check Out”
 - **Note: You may check out 5 books at a time. You can also return books early (see below).**
- Click the “Get for Kindle” button (your expiration date is noted on right side)
- You will now be directed to the Amazon.com website. If you have not done so already, you will be asked to create an account.
- Click the yellow “Get Library Book” button on the Amazon page. Log into your account (*or create one now*).
- Choose desired device from drop-down menu. Click “Continue.” At this point, Amazon will deliver the book to the chosen device automatically the next time it is connected to Wi-Fi.
 - Or, if necessary, plug your Kindle into your computer with a USB cable. Click “Download Now,” then choose “Save” and select “My Computer” to find your Kindle as a drive. Save to your Kindle under the folder entitled “Documents.”
- **NOTE: To Return Books Early:** Go to Amazon.com and log into your account. Scroll down to “Digital Content” (left column) and choose “Manage Your Kindle.” Find the title and click the “Actions” button to the right. Click “Return” and your book will disappear.
