- Phones and cell phones
- TV's, VCR, stereos, and like audio and video equipment including cable/satellite
- DVDs, CDs, cassette tapes, 8-tracks, and VHS tapes
- Home electronics, blenders, toasters, irons, clocks, etc.
- White Goods: washers, dryers, stoves, dishwashers, furnaces, etc.
- Medical Equipment and all types diagnostic equipment
- Electrical, cabling, Christmas lights, and communication machinery and equipment
